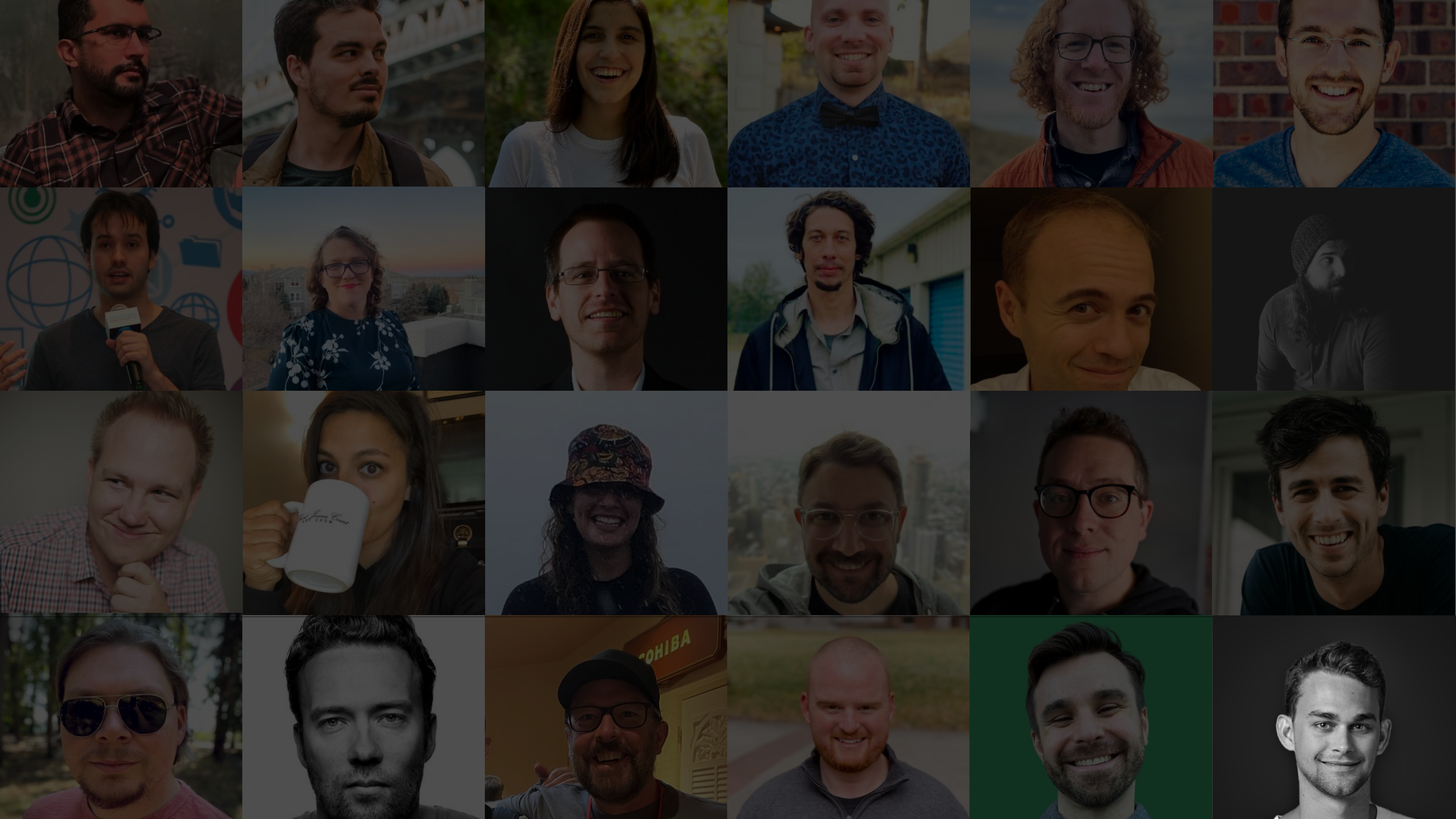












Get guests

What guest preparation looks like

- Be comfortable asking people to join
 - Keep it concise, flattering, and simple to setup
- Before recording...
 - Prepare any questions you'd like to ask
 - Ask the guest if there's anything they'd like to talk about
- Make the guest the star of the episode
- Give them a platform to share where people can find them

Get guests

What unwanted guests look like

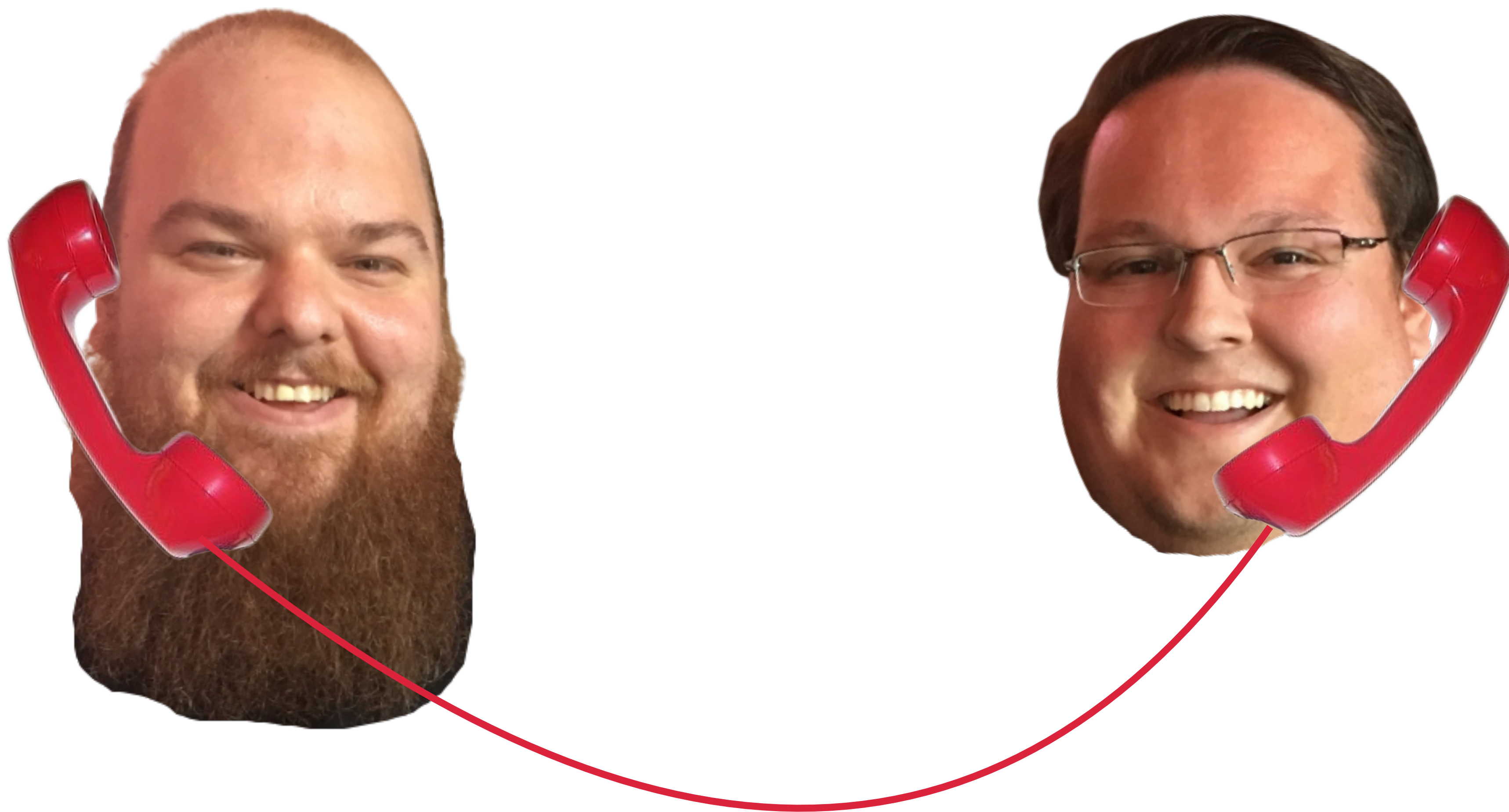
- Know your audience
 - If it's not a good fit, politely pass (or ignore)
- If you're unsure...
 - Do some research- have they been on other podcasts?
 - Do an introductory call- ask them to chat with you and feel it out

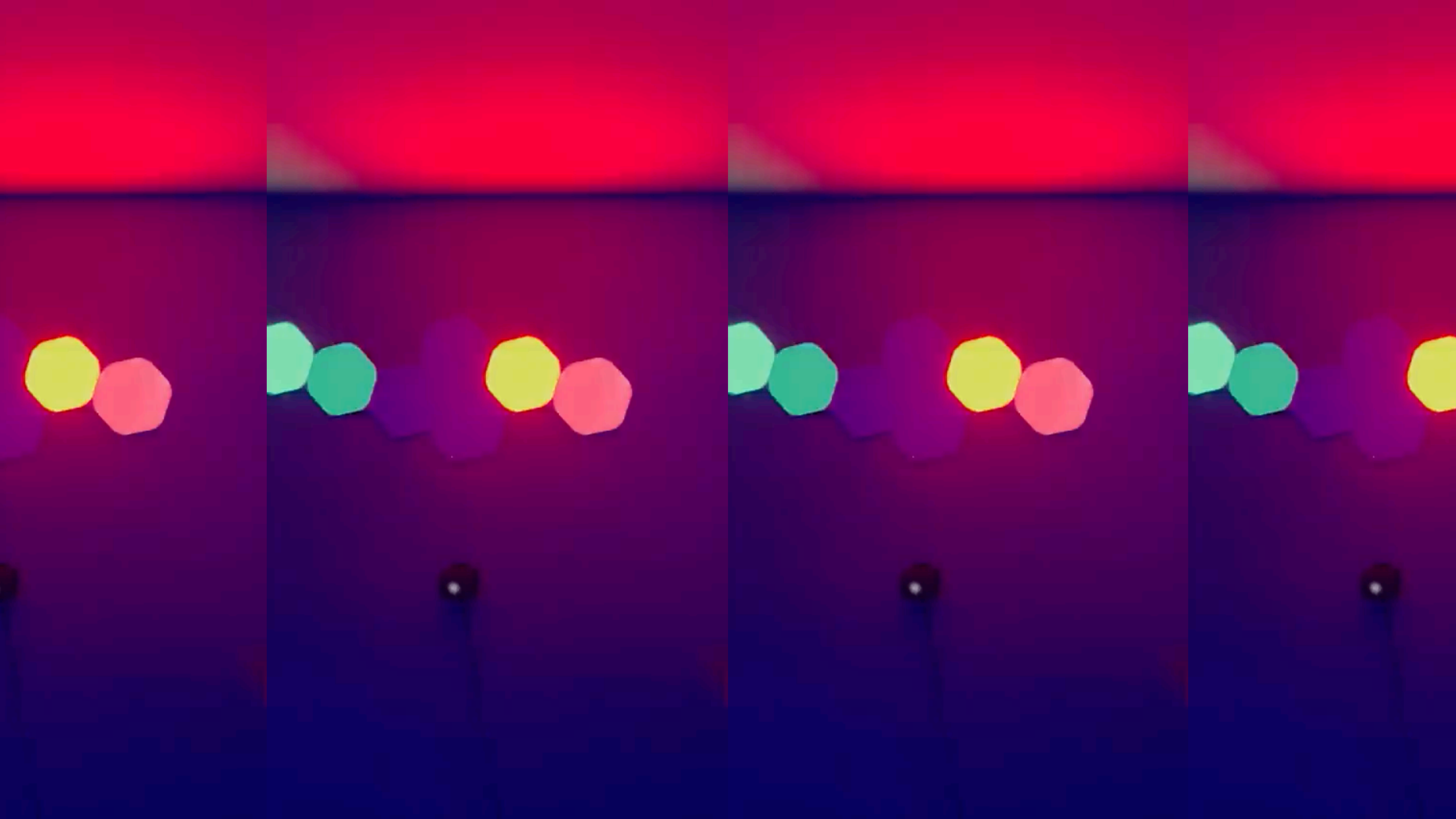

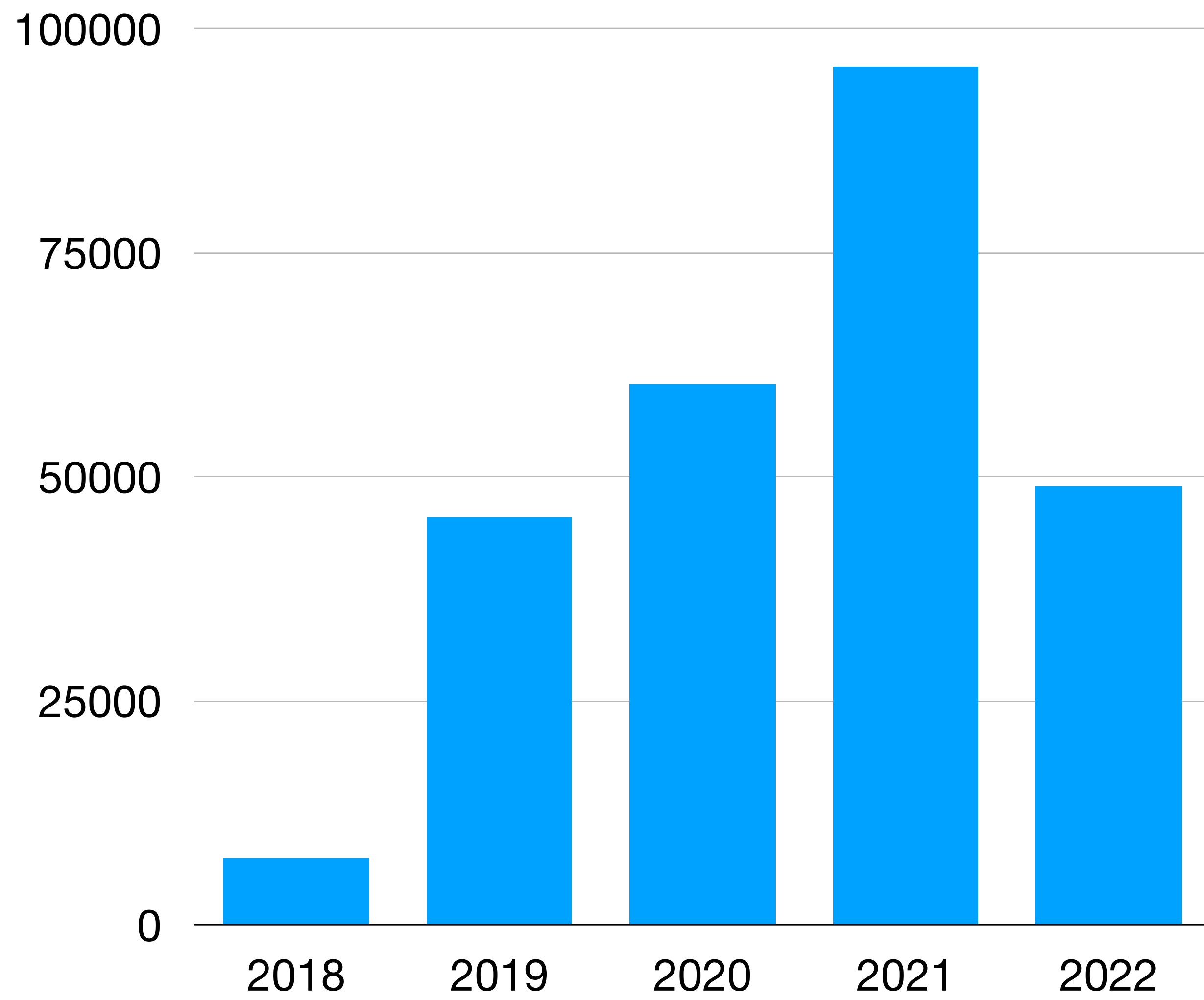












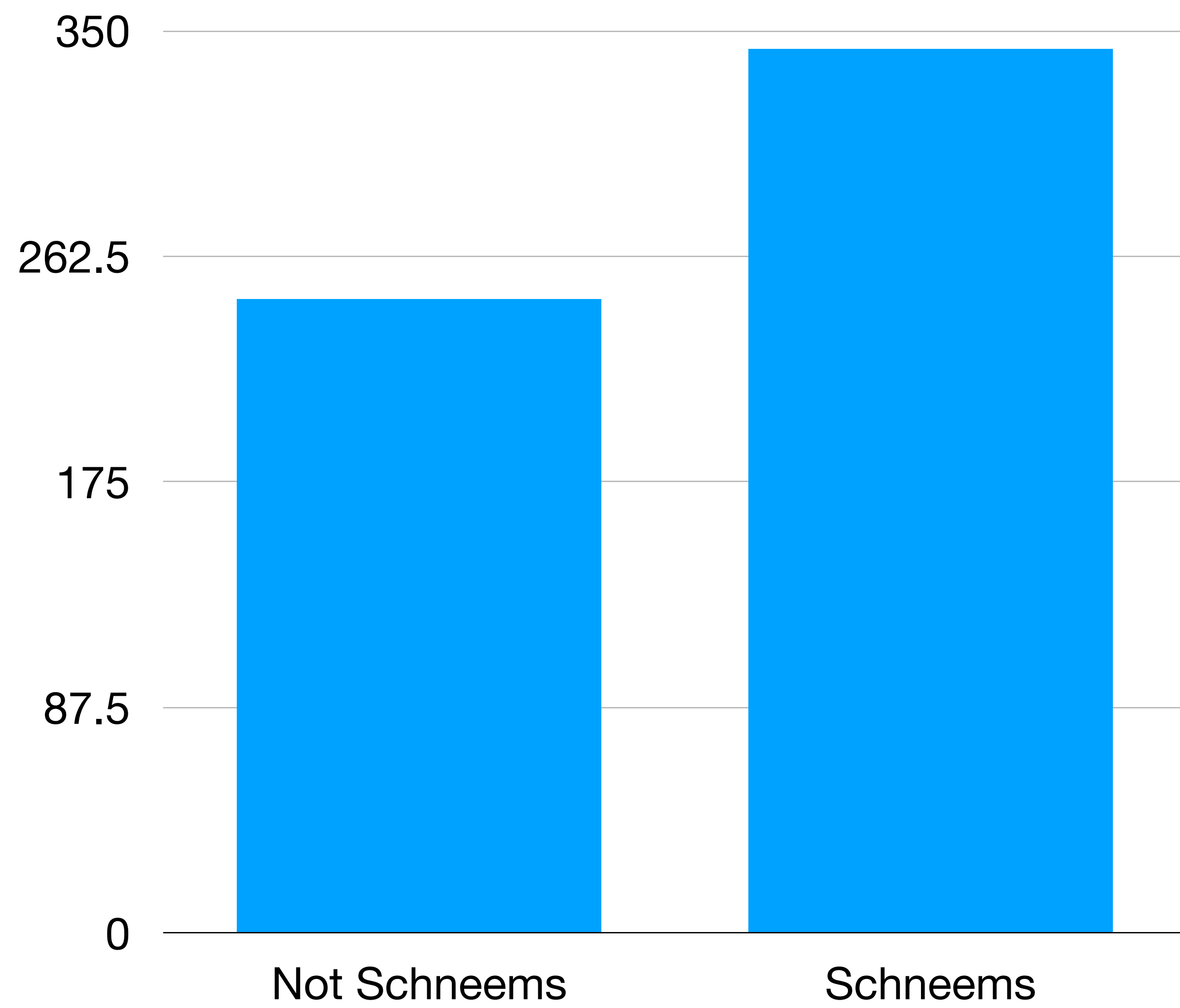
Stay steady

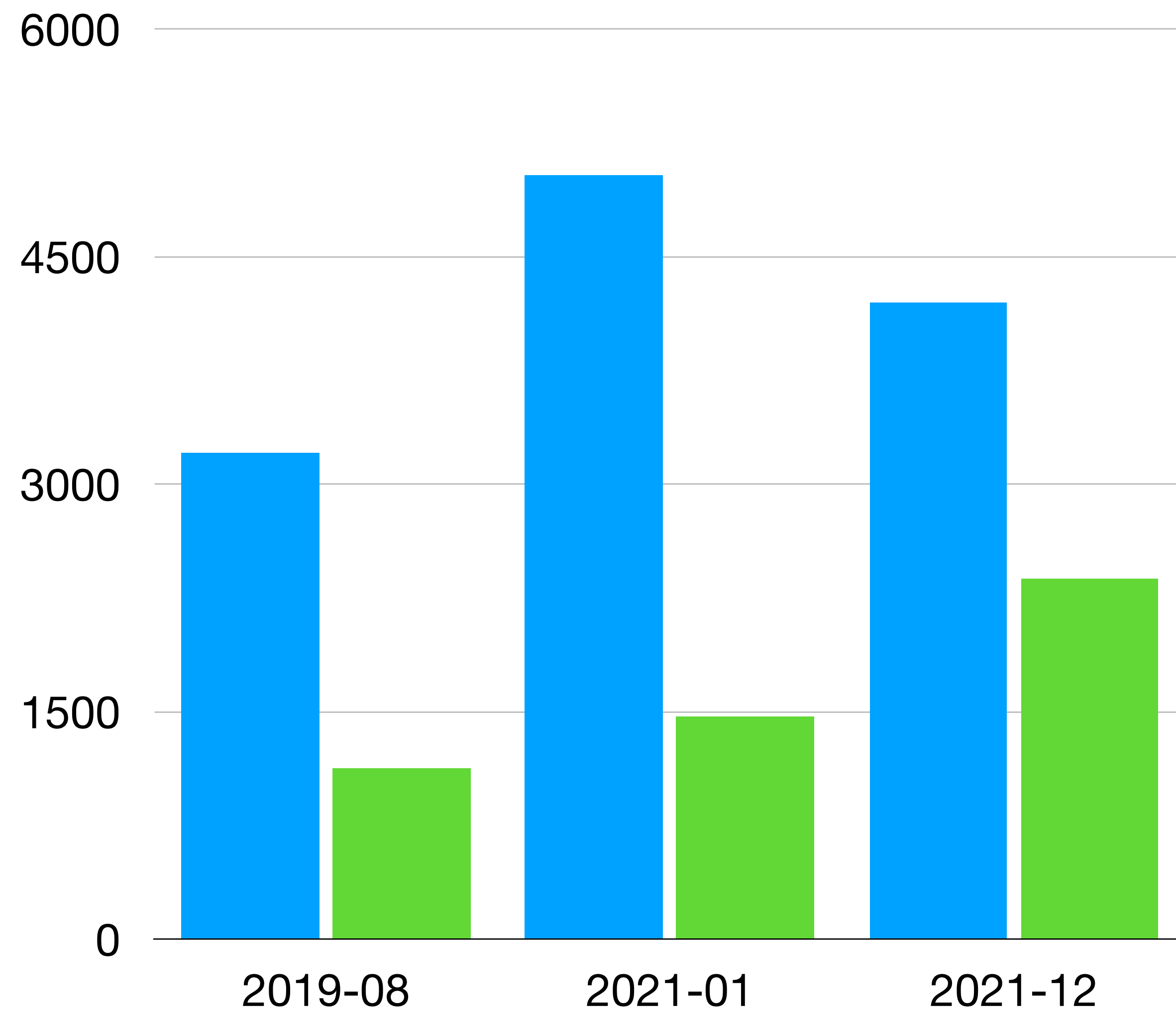
What that looks like

- Double up to get ahead
 - With extra episodes you don't need a backup plan when life happens
